MOTHER & CHILD CAMPAIGN

Mother & Child Campaign is a crucial and influential lobby for life, faith and family in Ireland today. It has emerged as the key voice in recent important debates on issues such as the constitutional family, the sanctity of marriage, and the right to life from conception until birth. Recent successes include:

o Defending the Family: Organising a nationwide response which gathered tens of thousands of profamily submissions to the *All Party Oireachtas Committee on the Constitution*

o Creating a positive pro-life ethos: printing more than 300,000 of our ground-breaking pro-life mother and baby booklet, *Your Baby and You*

o Promoting the faith: bringing young people to see *The Passion*; the movie of the Greatest Story ever told

o Launching the Family First project which works to protect and inform the traditional family. The project successfully opposed anti-family measures proposed in the December 2005 Budget



YOUTH DEFENCE

Youth Defence are Ireland's foremost pro-life activists. Described as "the cutting edge" of the pro-life movement they have maintained a prolife majority in Ireland by focusing on education, lobbying and communicating. In 1995 they were told by the late, great Pope John Paul II to "Continue in your aposolate and be courageous" and they followed that instruction. Youth Defence are now the primary source of pro-life information for most Irish people.

YD members are pro-life leaders in colleges and schools throughout the country. They have won praise for their continued, courageous stance against abortion and are widely credited with keeping Ireland abortion free.

Great Speakers Inspired



BOBBY SCHINDLER WASHINGTON, USA

Bobby Schindler is the brother of the late Terry Schiavo who was starved to death in March 2004, following the court-ordered removal of her feeding tube, in a tragedy that rocked America.

Since then Bobby has worked fulltime to meet the great need for a sound, organised defence of our most vulnerable citizens. Bobby has called international attention to the need to protect disabled persons from euthanasia advocates. A Catholic school teacher, he directs the *Terri Schindler-Schiavo Foundation*.



DR. DAVID PRENTICE LONDON, UK

Dr. David A. Prentice is Senior Fellow for Life Sciences at Family Research Council, and an Affiliated Scholar for the Centre for Clinical Bioethics in Georgetown University.

He is a founding member of Do No Harm which strongly opposes the use of human embryos in research or cloning. Dr. Prentice is an internationallyrecognised expert on stem cell research and cloning, and has testified before the U.S. Congress and the European Parliament. What he has to say is unmissable.



DANA ROSEMARY SCALLON GALWAY, IRELAND

Dana is a successful singer/composer turned politician. She broke the traditional three party dominance in the 1997 Presidential election, and went on to win a seat in the EU Parliament. As an MEP she campaigned courageously on family values, most notably in her opposition to abortion and embryo research. She was rewarded in 2004 with the Outstanding Parliamentarian Award presented in Rome by the International Federation of Catholic Families and Catholic Doctors and was personally congratulated by the then Cardinal Ratzinger, the 2005 recipient of this prestigious award.



PROF. MACIEJ GIERTYCH, MEP, POLAND

Maciej Giertych was elected to the Polish Parliament from Pozna*f* constituency in September 2001 and in June 2004, he became a Member of the European Parliament for the *League of Polish Families* (LPR). Together with the rest of his party he is a member of the Independence and Democracy faction in the EU parliament. He is a strong opponent of the European Constitution and a critic of the federalist trend of the European Union. He was a founder and promoter of the successful Polish Catholic radio station Rosa Maria which has proved hugely influential in Poland.



DR. ESHAN DIAS, SRI LANKA

Eshan Dias is the founder of the Sri Lankan pro-life movement - *Cultura Vitae*. His work includes creating awareness of the lies associated with the culture of death through seminars; showing of films; writing to newspapers and journals; chastity education programmes; prayers outside abortuaries; explaining the evils of contraception and the contraceptive mentality; organising prayer and penance campaigns within convents; etc. *Cultura Vitae* was spurred into formation because of attempts to legalise abortion in Sri Lanka by incorporating the UN CEDAW international law.







JOSEPH M. SCHEIDLER, CHICAGO, USA

Joseph Scheidler is a powerful and moving speaker. His life-long and courageous involvement in pro-life campaigning has won him the accolade of the father of pro-life activism. He was the first to give former abortion providers a platform to tell the truth about what happens in abortion clinics. He recently won a major victory in the US Supreme Court following a ten year legal battle against abortionists who had falsely accused him of racketeering.

Bernadette Smyth, North of Ireland

Bernie Smyth founded *Precious Life,* North of Ireland in 1997. A mother of four, she has rejuvenated the pro-life community in the North. She has inspired many with her motivational speeches and has become a popular and sought after speaker. Her hard work and commitment, and the love she has for unborn babies and their mothers, makes her a tireless campaigner.

BRANDI SWINDELL, IDAHO, USA

Brandi Swindell is the Director of *Generation Life* which leads and organises many pro-life events across the US. Their campaigns include a series of successful demonstrations at the Salt Lake Olympics to prevent *Planned Parenthood's* condom distribution to minors, speaking out against embryonic stem cell research and cloning at the White House, and helping lead pro-life witnesses at Republican and Democratic Party Presidential Conventions.

INESE SLESERE, MP, LATVIA

Inese Slesere is a Latvian MEP and a member of the European Affairs Committee. She has been a key speaker at the World Family Forum and the World Family Congress and is a passionate pro-life and family advocate. She has overseen the introduction of pro-family policies in Latvia. She is an expert in English Philology by training. Mrs. Slesere also was an observer to, and for a short time, a member of the European Parliament.



FIONA PINTO ENGLAND

Fiona Pinto has directed UK *Student LifeNet*, and stood as a *ProLife Alliance* electoral candidate. She was arrested for holding up an image of a 21 week old aborted foetus whilst campaigning in the elections.

She has an MSc in medical ethics and has worked as a bioethics researcher for CORE, leading a legal challenge against the creation of designer babies and human cloning licences. She is foremost is a new generation of young pro-life activists in England.





BRYAN KEMPER USA

Bryan Kemper is the founder of Rock For Life, a pro-life music ministry for young people. He is now the director of Stand True, and his cry of "stop killing my generation!" inspires youth to take a stand and become active. Bryan is an inspirational speaker who uses music as a tool to spread the pro-life message





JOHN WATERS, IRELAND

As a journalist, magazine editor and columnist, John Waters has specialised in raising unpopular issues of public importance, including the repression of Famine memories and the cultural abuse in modern societies of men and fathers. He is one of Ireland's most respected journalists and writes a weekly column for *The Irish Times* among other papers. His books include: An *Intelligent Person's Guide to Modern Ireland* and *The Politburo Has decided That You Are Unwell*. He has written plays for radio and the stage.

DR. SEÁN O'DOMHNAILL, IRELAND

Dr. Seán O'Domhnaill has been to the forefront of the defence of Life and Family in Ireland for many years. A clinical psychiatrist, he is the co-author of the ground-breaking medical report *Women have the Right to Know: Adverse Effects of Induced Abortion.* As a spokesman for the Mother & Child Campaign he strongly defended the traditional family based on marriage before the *Dáil Committee on the Constitution.* Seán and his wife Fionnuala have six children. He is also a popular columnist for the *Irish Family.*
