THE ORGANISERS:

YOUTHDEFENCE is Ireland's only pro-life organisation that is led and run by young people. Whether we are students, nurses, brickies or teachers, we've one thing in common; we know that abortion is wrong. That's why we work to protect mothers and babies from being exploited and killed by the abortion industry.

Our campaigns and activities reach people on many levels; on the streets, on college campuses, on the web, in schools and outside abortion referral agencies. We aim to provide real information on abortion, and to find new ways of getting that information to the public. Most of all, we believe that Ireland can be kept abortion-free.





Precious Life is the largest pro-life group in Northern Ireland and works actively on the streets and at clinics every day. We are composed of people from all sections of the community who care deeply about unborn children and their mothers.

SPEAKER SPOTLIGHT:

DANA ROSEMARY SCALLON from Derry is a former MEP and singer. She was elected as a Member of the European Parliament in 1999, representing Ireland's Connacht-Ulster constituency, and during her time there, was a very active and outspoken advocate for the unborn child. She was the firrst woman to be awarded the highly acclaimed San Benedetto Award for her outstanding work in defending family and life and was honoured to be personally congratulated by the then Cardinal Ratzinger, now Pope Benedict XVI.



Dana has long been established as one of Ireland's

most successful entertainers, having enjoyed outstanding acclaim through best selling recordings, top-rating television appearances, and headlined major concerts both in Ireland and abroad. She was famously Ireland's first winner of the Eurovision Song Contest, with the song, 'All Kinds Of Everything'. In the midst of a very successful career in music, Dana started to speak publicly about her faith, and she and her husband, Damien, began writing Christian songs together. Dana has remained close to her Irish roots, and her music and witness to life and family values has earned her respect as a spokesperson for the Christian family and the pro-life movement. In February 2011, Dana joined with Kathy Sinnott and over 30 pro-life and community groups in Ireland to form All-Ireland United for Life.
